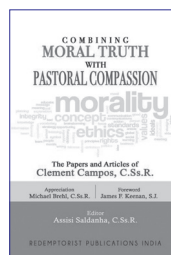


## NEW CHARTER FOR HEALTH CARE WORKERS: Pontifical Council for Health Care Workers

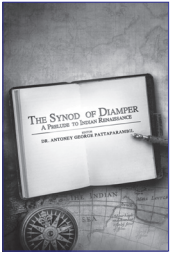


**HISTORY OF JESUITS IN KERALA 1879-2000**: by Sunny Jose, SJ

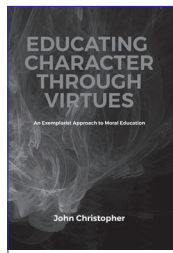


**THE IGNATIAN CEO - Leadership Modelled on Saint Ignatius of Loyola:** by Sahayaraj John Stanley, SJ

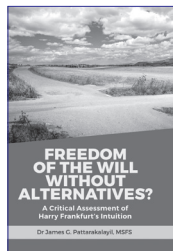


## EDUCATING CHARACTER THROUGH VIRTUES
